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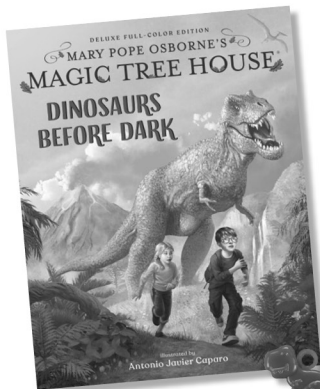
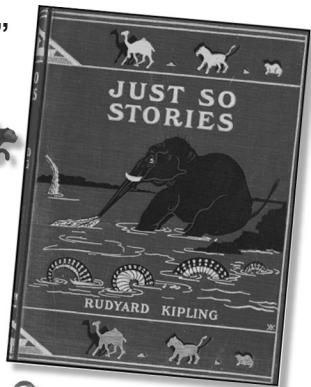
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TEACHER'S TIP

“How do I use Build a Zoo?”
